The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) is a bi-county agency, empowered to acquire, develop, maintain and administer a regional system of parks in a defined Metropolitan District within the Maryland Counties—Montgomery and Prince George's adjacent to the District of Columbia. The Commission is also empowered to prepare and administer a general plan for the physical development of a larger Regional District in the same area.

WHAT WE DO...

The **Prince George's County Planning Board** provides direction to M-NCPPC's work in the county through **Prince George's County Planning Department** and the **Prince George's County Department of Parks and Recreation**. Our responsibilities include:

- Professional land use planning, zoning and development services and advice in the areas of community planning, countywide planning, development review, and information analysis
- Preparation of master plans, sector plans, specialized planning studies, population forecasts, data analysis, and the geographical information
- Review of development applications and processes
- Acquisition, development, operation and maintenance of open space and parkland
- Maintenance and operation of ball fields, parks, playgrounds, recreation buildings, historic sites, ice rinks, tennis courts, arts facilities, forty-five community centers, and more
- Direction and management of the county's public recreation program

Envision Prince George's engages all stakeholders across the County as active participants to provide input into the direction of the County's future.
